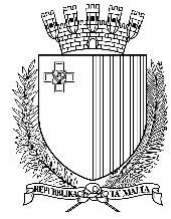

Dmirijiet u responsabbiltajiet

- i. Jagħmel xogħol ta' mastrudaxxa u *joiner*, waqt li jaħdem fuq il-bank u l-magni;
- ii. Jissettja u jhaddem magni, inkluż serrieq tal-elettriku, magni ta' kalibrazzjoni, xkatlar, tgħaqqid tal-injam, tal-bejtiet tal-minċotti, tal-minċotti u tal-iffurmar, biex jaqta' u jiffirma injam u sostituti tiegħu;
- iii. Jiddistingwi u jiddefinixxi l-injam abbażi tat-tip, il-karatteristiċi, l-użu u l-limitazzjonijiet;
- iv. Jaħdem fuq inizjattiva tiegħu u jippossjedi ħiliet biex isolvi l-problemi;
- v. Jifhem u jaħdem minn fuq disinji, pjanti, struzzjonijiet verbali jew bil-miktub;
- vi. Ikun kapaċi jimmanifattura, isewwi, jirrestawra u jimmonta kull tip ta' għamara b'kull tip ta' injam bħal bibien, gwarniċi tat-twieqi, aperturi, *partitions* u turgien;
- vii. Jgħaqqad fuq il-lant l-oġġetti tal-injam maħduma fil-ħanut tal-mastrudaxxi;
- viii. Ikollu għarfien tal-materjali u l-lostru l-aktar adattati għax-xogħol involut;
- ix. Jagħmel il-kalkoli adattati biex jistabilixxi l-kwantitajiet tal-materjal li jkun hemm bżonn għal kwalunkwe proġett;
- x. Jidentifika r-riskji tas-saħħa u s-sigurtà li għandhom x'jaqsmu max-xogħol u jagħmel kull sforz biex inaqqas kwistjonijiet ta' sigurtà fuq il-post tax-xogħol;
- xi. Iwettaq kwalunkwe komputu ieħor li s-superjur jista' jiddelega lilu/ha kif jista' jkun meħtieġ; u
- xii. Iwettaq kwalunkwe dmir ieħor hekk kif ordnat mis-Segretarju Permanenti Ewlieni.

Duties and responsibilities

- i. Undertakes carpentry and joinery work, working at bench or machines;
- ii. Sets up and operates machines, including power saws, calibration, sanding, jointers, mortisers, tenoners, and shapers, to cut, mold and shape woodstock and wood substitutes;
- iii. Distinguishes and defines timber based on its type, characteristics, uses and limitations;
- iv. Works on own initiative and possesses problem-solving skills;
- v. Understands and works from drawings, plans and written or spoken instructions;
- vi. Manufactures, repairs, restores and assembles all kinds of furniture in all kinds of timber such as doors, window frames, apertures, partitions and staircases;
- vii. Assembles on site the timber articles manufactured in the carpentry workshop;
- viii. Has the knowledge of the right materials and furniture polish appropriate to the work involved;
- ix. Makes appropriate calculations to establish quantities of material required for any project;
- x. Recognizes occupational health and safety hazards and makes every effort to alleviate safety issues at workplace;
- xi. Undertakes any other tasks which the superior may delegate to him/her as may be required;
- xii. Undertakes any other duties as directed by the Principal Permanent Secretary.
